

The Salo Wittmayer Baron Dissertation Award in Jewish Studies is made possible by a generous gift from Dr. Shoshana B. Tancer and Robert S. Tancer. Named for Shoshana Tancer’s father, Professor Salo Wittmayer Baron—the most important Jewish historian in the 20th century—this award is given to the best dissertation in the field of Jewish History and Culture in the Americas.

A \$5,000 (USD) award is granted every three years. Competition is open to dissertations completed at U.S. universities since the previous award was granted.
